Defendant's bail was ordered forfeited by this court on _____, and notice of forfeiture was mailed to moving party on _____. The 180th day from forfeiture mailing herein is therefore _____.

Where it is shown that an errant defendant who has forfeited bail is detained by civil authorities in another jurisdiction (or forum), or that he/she is medically disabled, a moving surety is, at a minimum, entitled to a tolling of time of the 180 day period contained within Section 1305 PC. Los Angeles County v. Surety Ins. Co. of California (1984) 152 Cal. App. 3d 16. If the Court views the defendant's disability as more than a temporary one, exoneration may be appropriate. Penal Code Section 1305.
